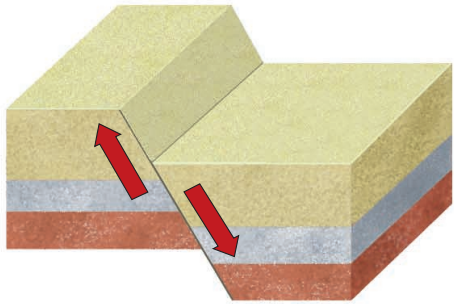
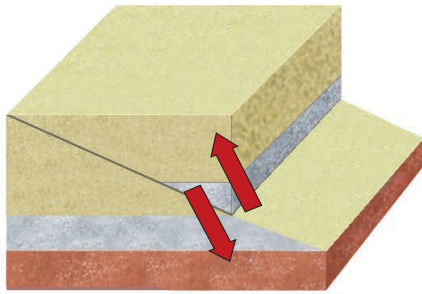


Common Types of Faults



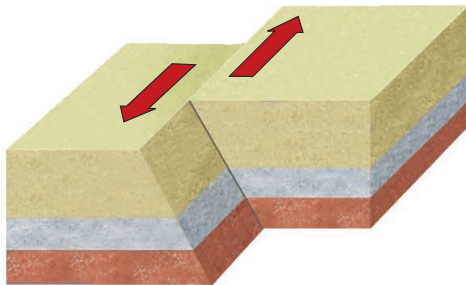
NORMAL FAULT

A normal fault is a fault along which the movement is vertical.



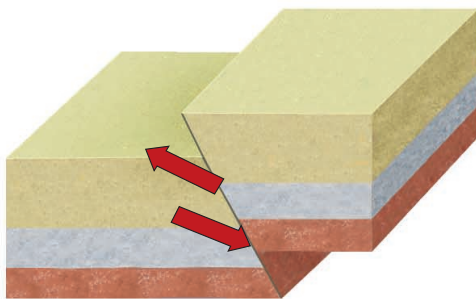
REVERSE FAULT

A reverse fault is a fault in which the crust above the fault plane rises in relation to the crust below.



STRIKE-SLIP FAULT

A strike-slip fault is a fault along which the movement is horizontal.



THRUST FAULT

A thrust fault is a low-angle reverse fault.
