

Phases of the Moon

Materials

- 1 envelope (per student) with cutouts representing the phases of the moon (similar to those found on page C51)
- construction paper
- glue

Helpful Information

- Explain that students will arrange representations of the phases of the moon in their proper sequence.

Preparation

1. Prepare the envelopes with cutouts beforehand.
2. Make an enlarged copy of the Set-up Card below to show the students the steps to follow to do the performance activity.
3. Explain the steps required to complete this activity.

Criteria

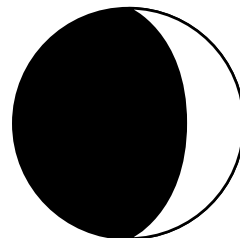
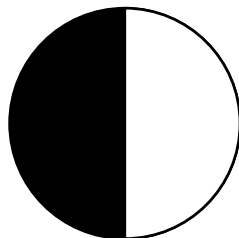
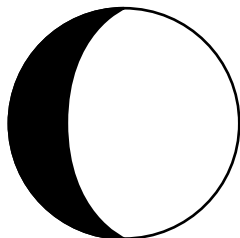
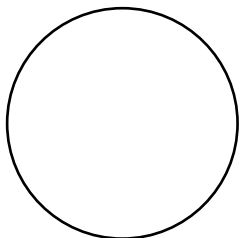
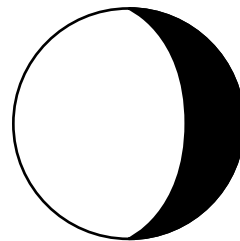
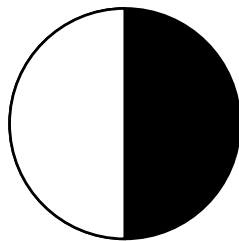
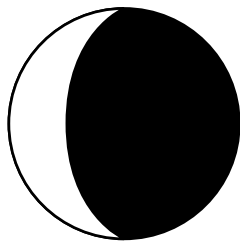
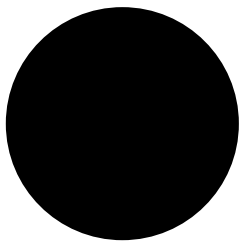
- 2 points Student accurately arranged the eight phases of the moon in proper sequence.

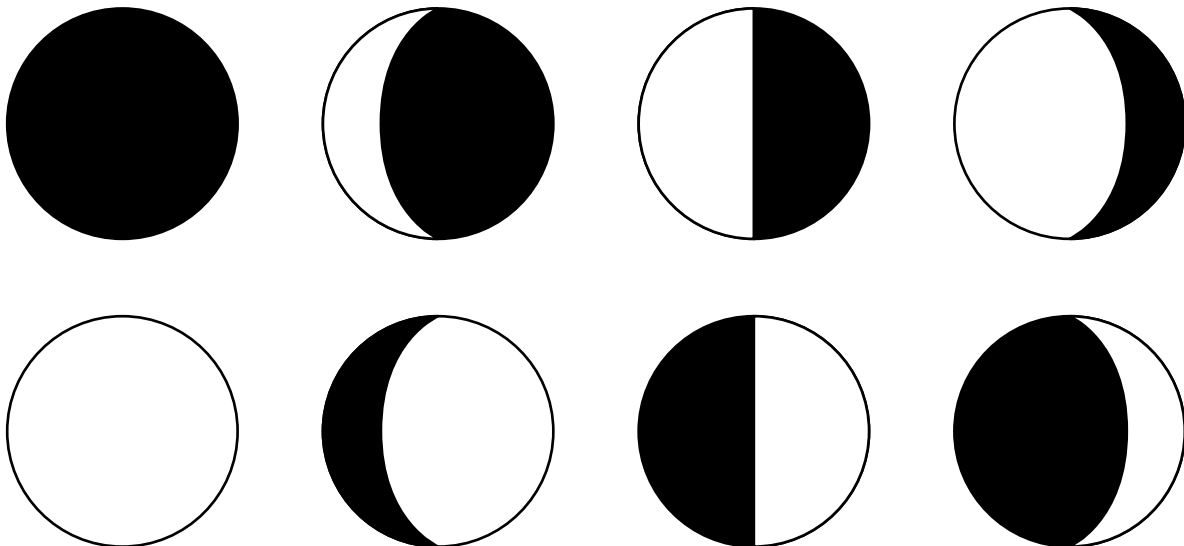
